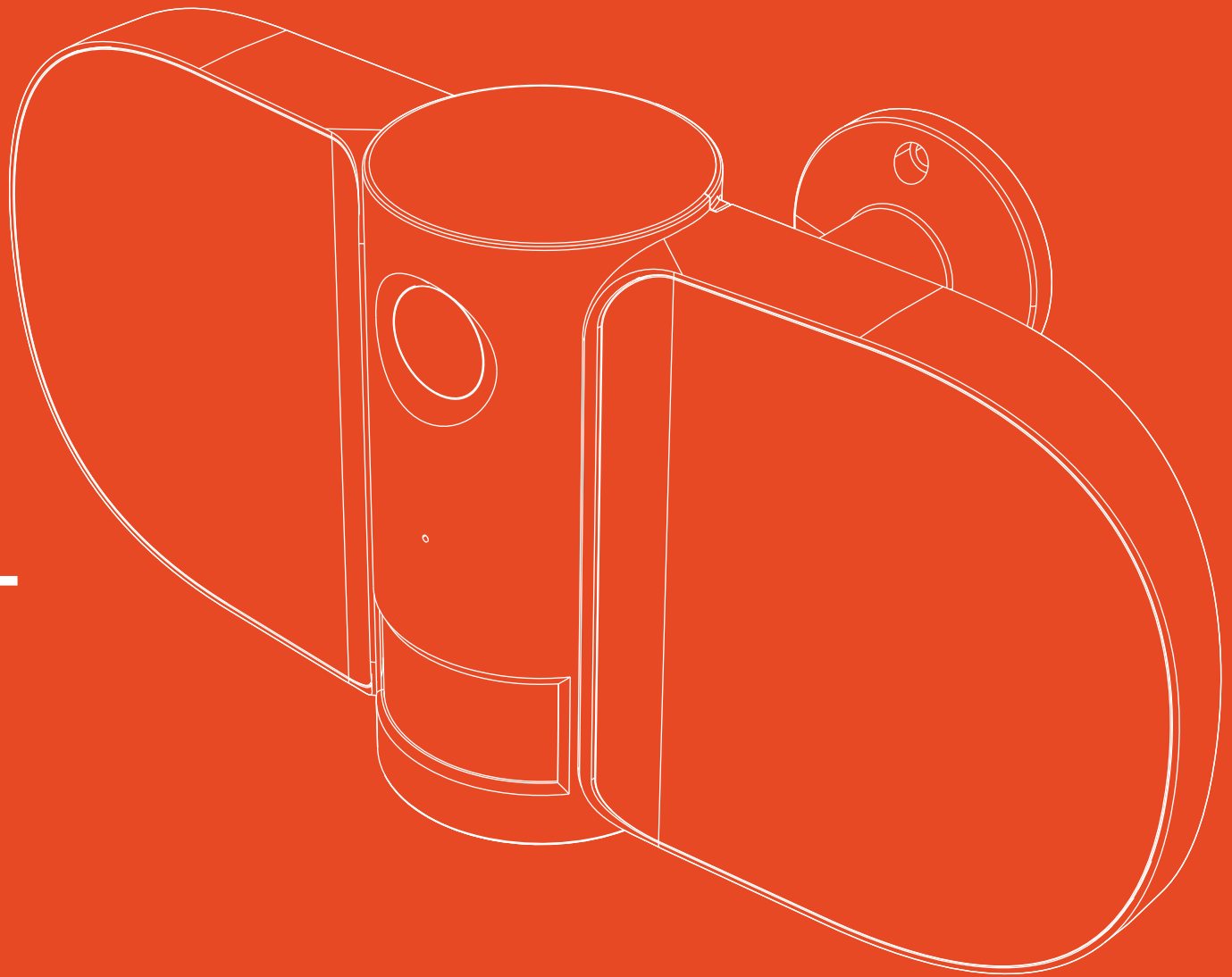

This is what you will need to set up your Luna floodlight camera



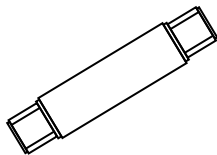
WiFi Broadband

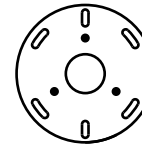

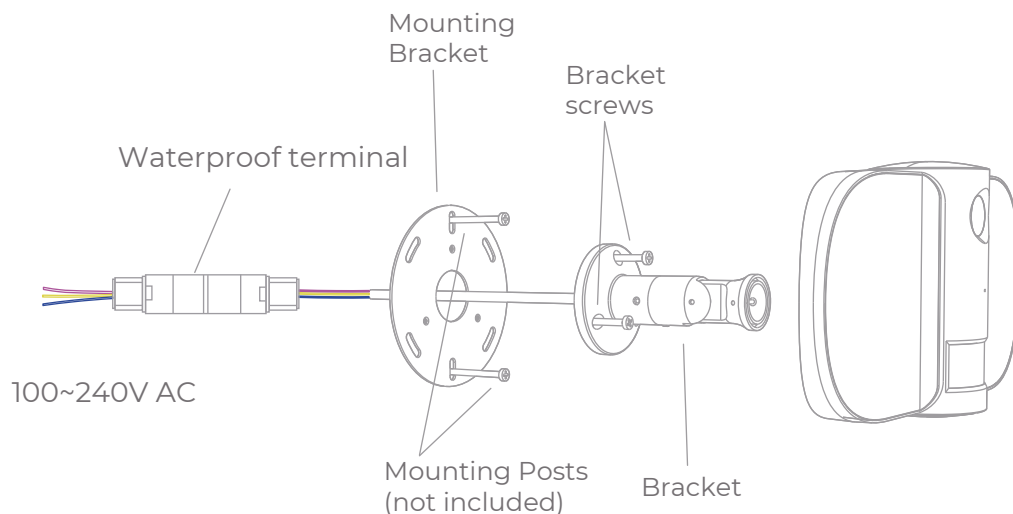

Installing Luna

The Luna Floodlight Camera must be installed according to local building regulations. We recommend this camera is installed by a professional installer.

Before starting the installation, you must follow these safety precautions:

- Turn off power at the fusebox before beginning installation
- Ensure that the supply voltage is correct
- The Earth wire must be connected to the light fixture.
Do not install if a working earth connection is not available!
- Do not connect this light fixture to a dimmer switch or timer!

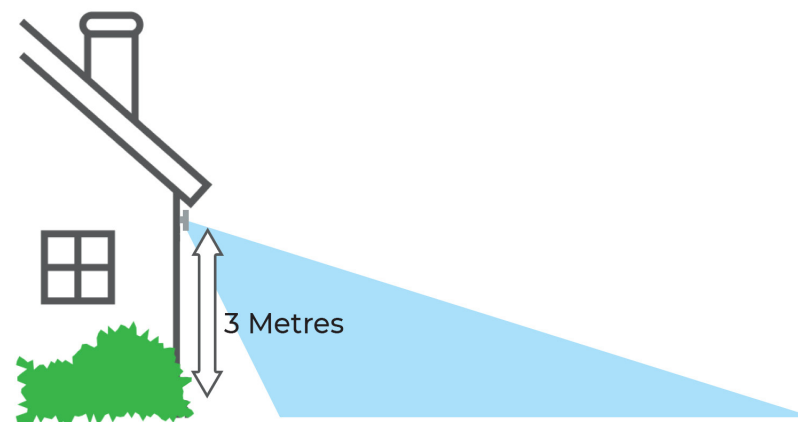


Choose a good spot

Luna has an adjustable head and a wide field of view so you can position it in any direction you want.

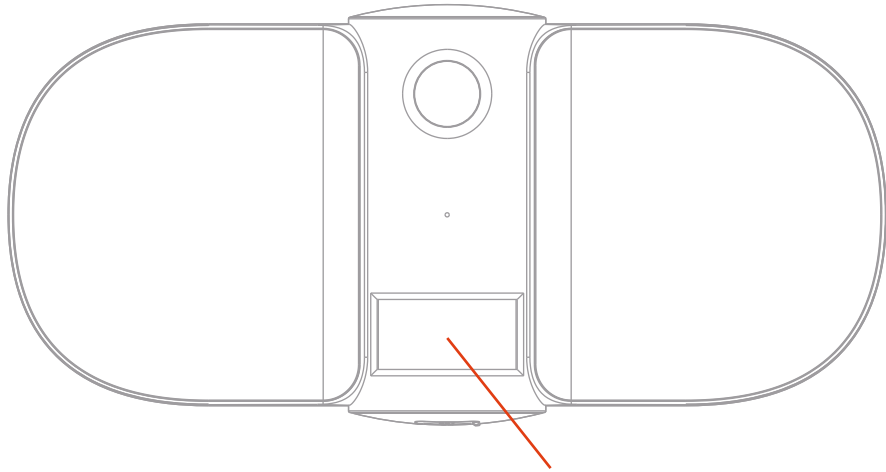
We recommend that you mount Luna at around 3 metres above the ground, this is the ideal position for Luna to sense movement, see faces and talk through the speaker and microphone.

Install height



Ensure that Luna is mounted in a position that allows you to see over a large area of your home and surroundings with an unblocked, clear view.

Let's get started



LED Light

Once Luna has been connected to power, the red LED light will come on and the camera will chime when it is ready to connect.

What do the flashing lights mean?

Add Luna to the Clan at Home App

If you're setting Luna up for the first time, you will need to:

1. Download the Clan at Home app from the Google Play Store or Apple App Store
2. Open the app and "register" to create an account
3. Create a Home
4. Add Luna

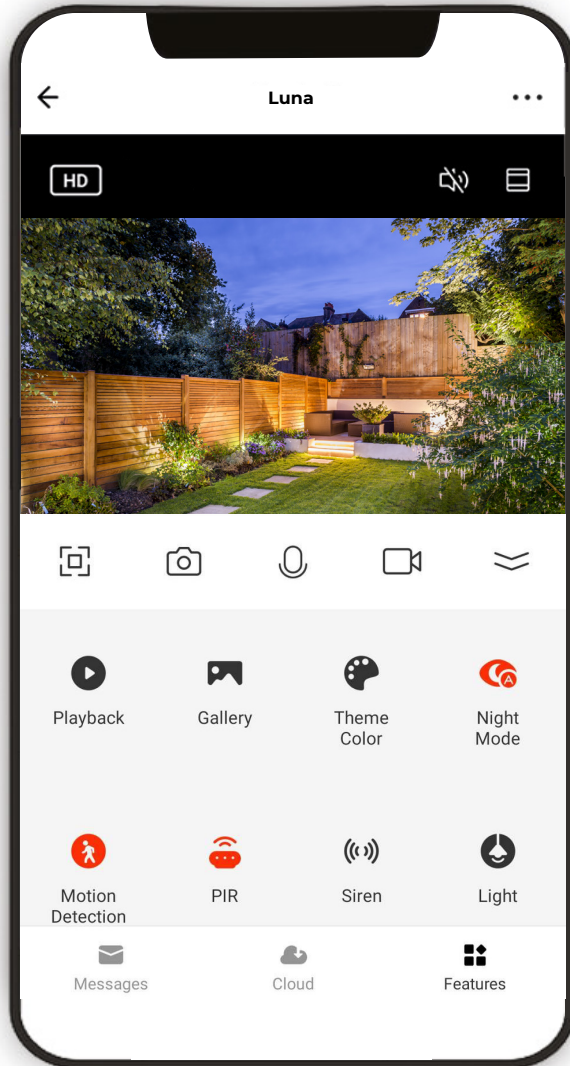
If you already have a Clan at Home account, simply press the "+" icon on the top right corner and follow the on-screen steps.

You will be asked to enter your Wi-Fi router password and use Luna to scan the QR code created on your smartphone, then Luna will connect to your Wi-Fi network.

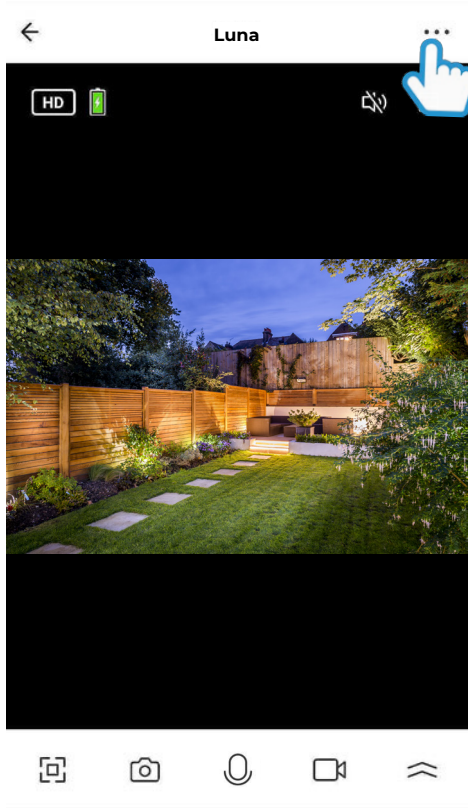

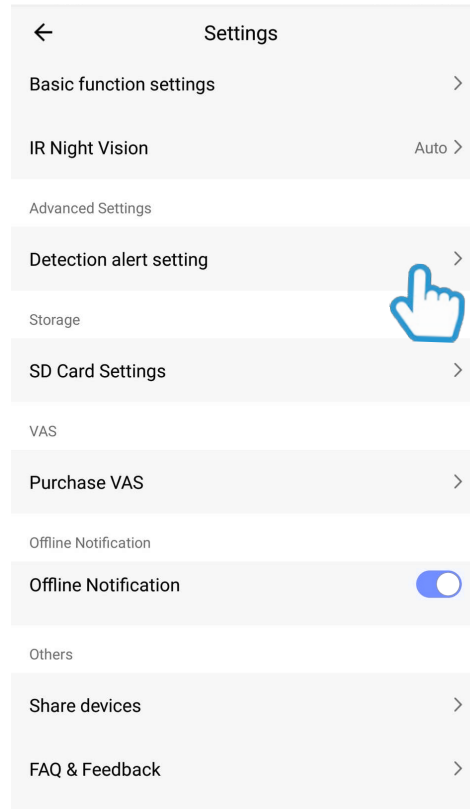

Motion Alerts



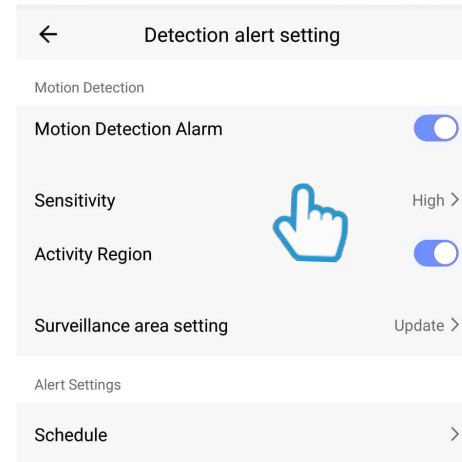
Step 1

Click the Settings icon to bring up the camera settings



Step 2

Select Detection alert setting



Step 3

Choose the sensitivity. Selecting a sensitivity level minimises false alerts.

You can also select an activity region. (See next page)

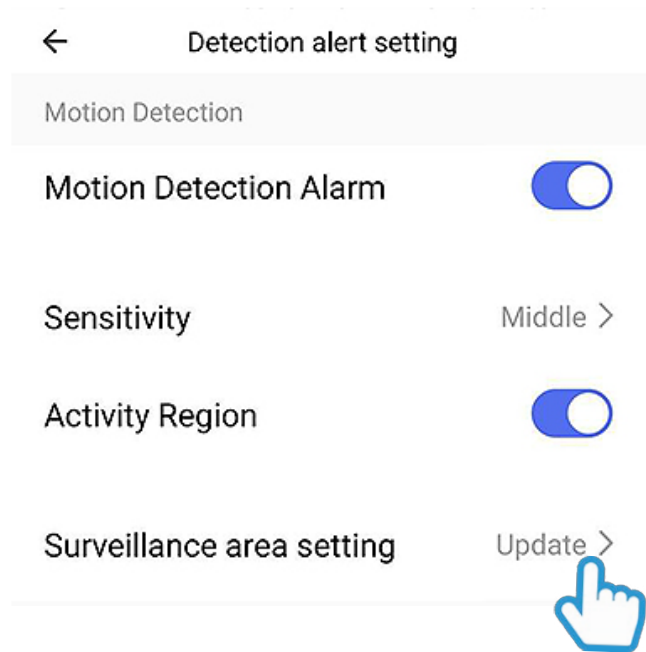
When movement is detected, Luna will send you alerts straight to your Smartphone or Tablet.

If your device is locked when Luna detects something, you will receive notifications on your home screen as long as you are signed in to the Clan at Home app



Activity Region

To set an activity region, follow the steps below:

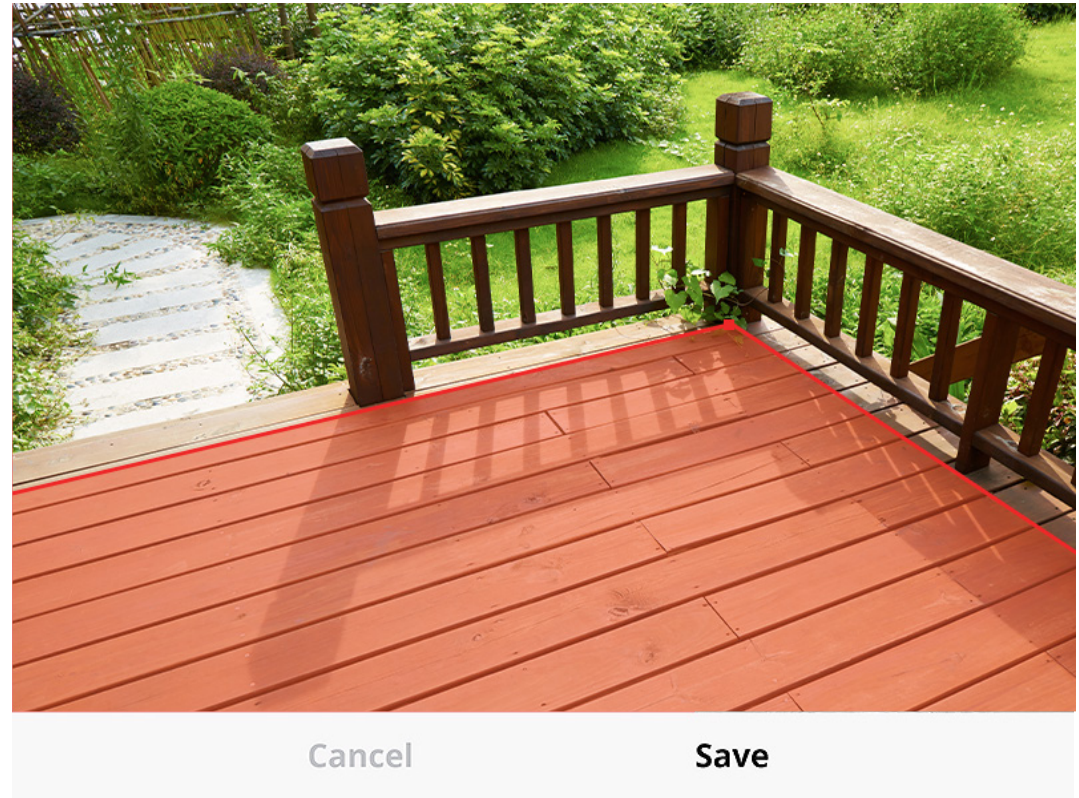


Step 1

Turn on the Activity Region

Step 2

Click "Surveillance area setting"



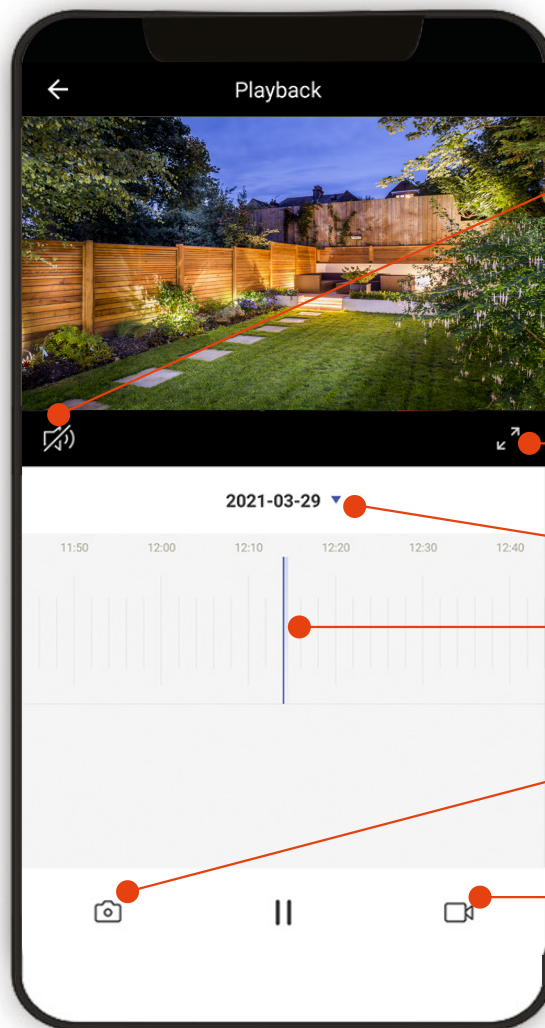
Step 3

Using the red square, select the area you wish to monitor.

Then click Save

Recordings

Luna automatically records for you when the doorbell is pressed or when movement has been detected, so you don't need to remember to press record. You can access the recordings from the Clan at Home app.

Choose the date

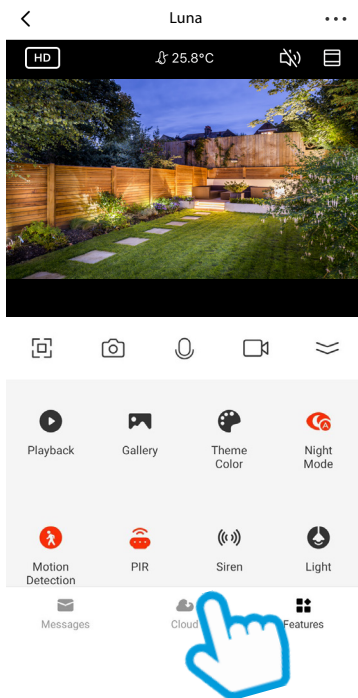
Slide to select the time you want to view. Pinch & zoom the timeline for a more accurate navigation

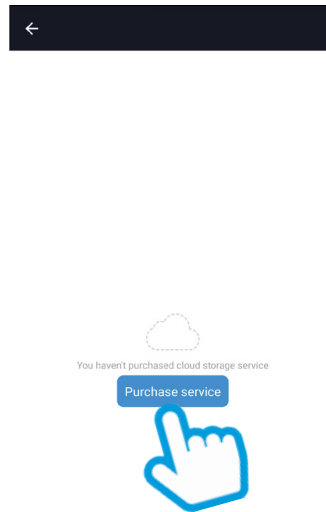
Cloud Storage for a single camera

Luna can record directly on to the cloud when movement has been detected. You can choose to store the recorded footage for 7 days, 14 days or even 30 days.



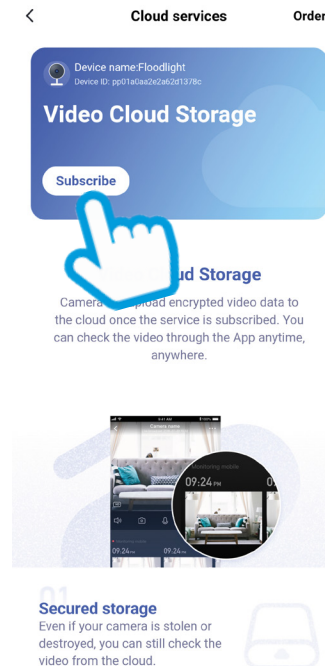

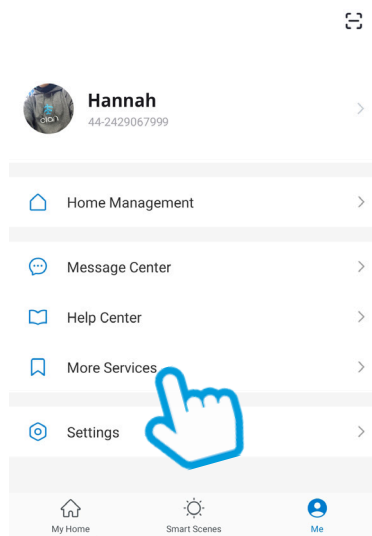
Cloud Storage for multiple cameras

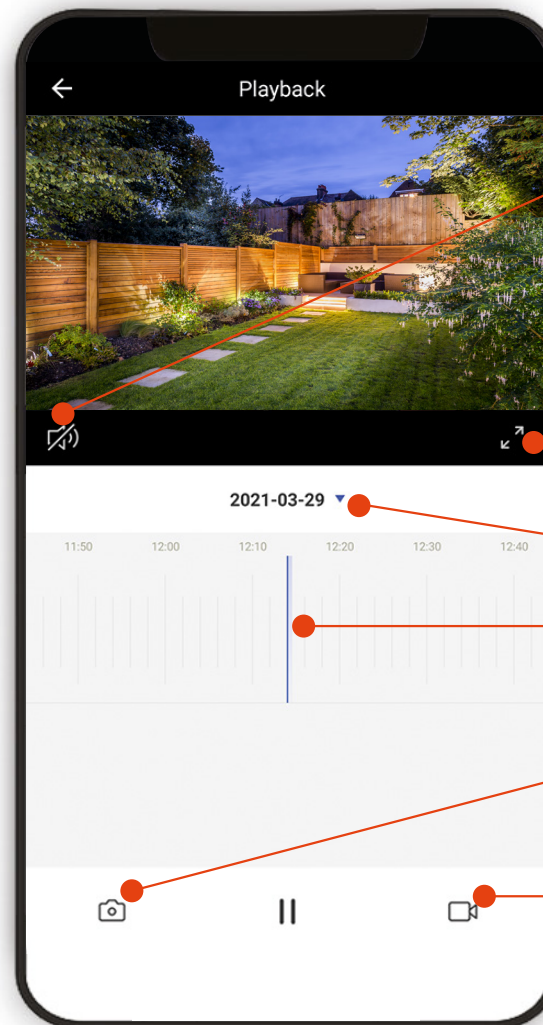
Cloud Storage Recordings

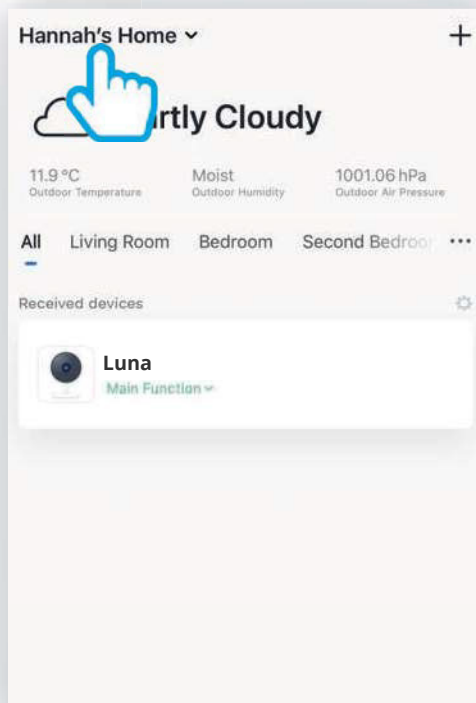

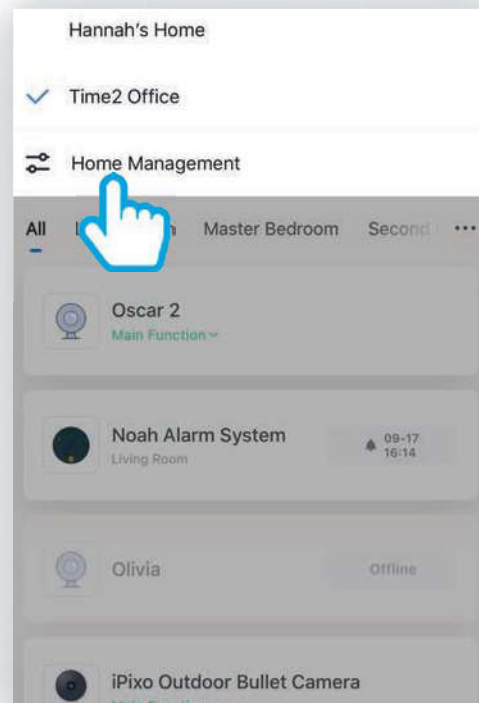
Managing your Clan home

To create a home or manage your home settings, see steps below:



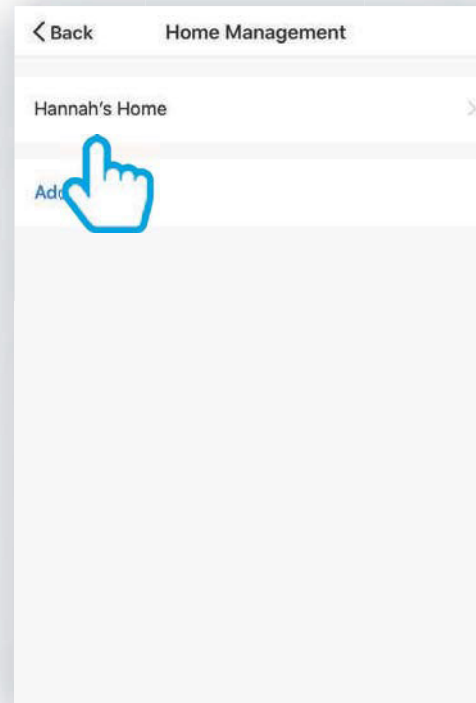
Step 1

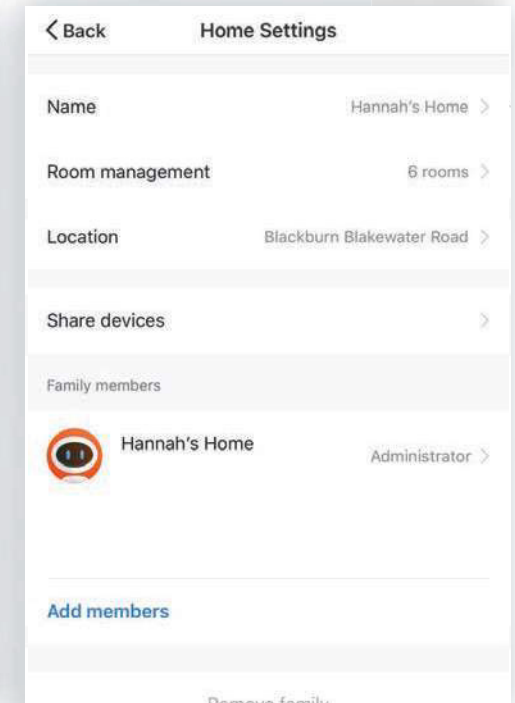

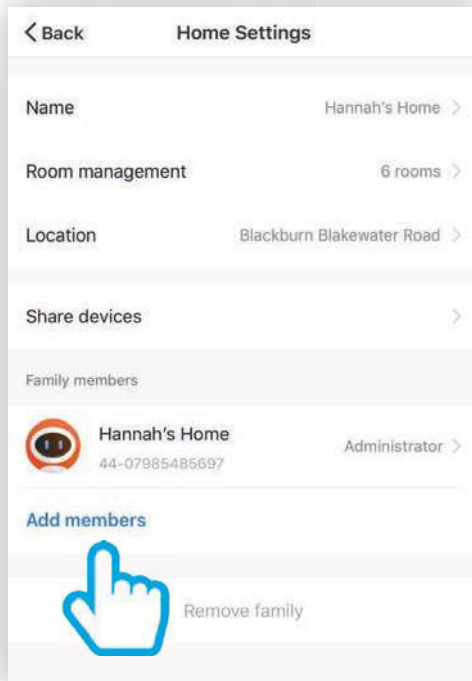

Change settings, change location or add a family member

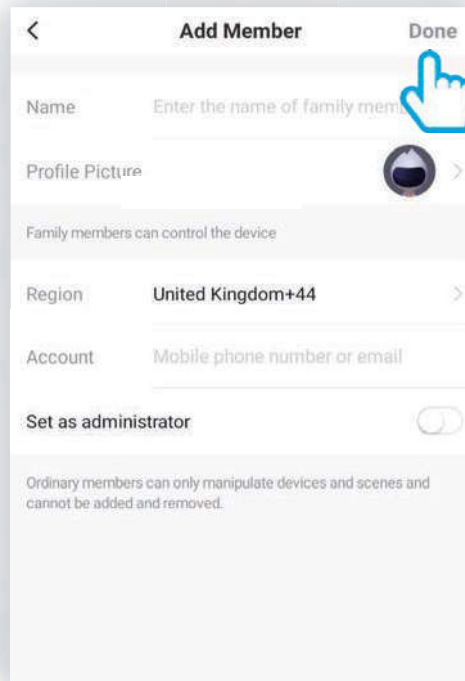
Add a Family Member

You are able to add Family Members to your home, this gives them access to all Clan devices in that home automatically so you don't have to share each device individually.



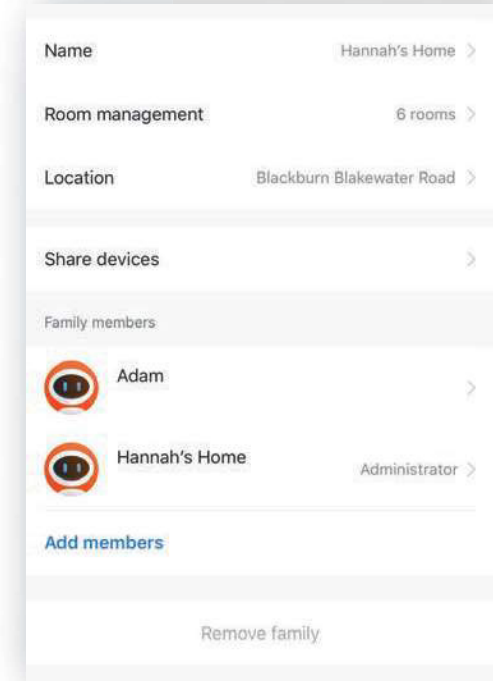
Step 1

Fill in the members name and Clan at Home account details. Setting the member as an administrator gives them full access to device settings.



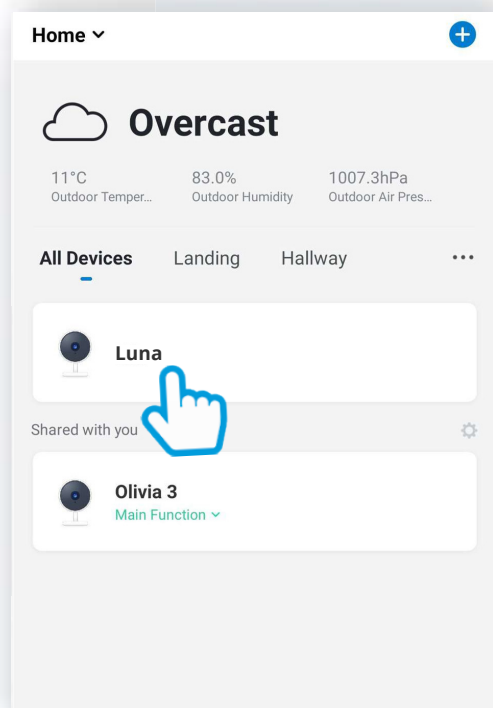

Share Luna

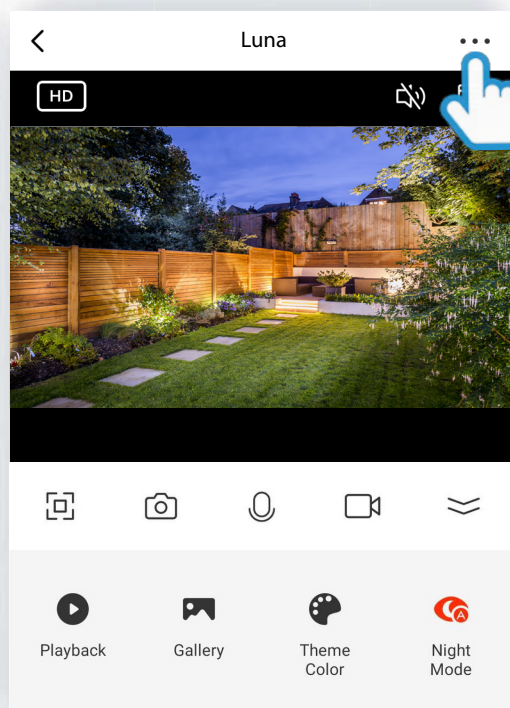
You are able to share Luna with family or friends so they can also have access to the camera - they must also have a registered Clan Account.

Sharing Luna will only give them access to the live-view, to give full access to Luna's settings, please see "Add a family member" on previous page.



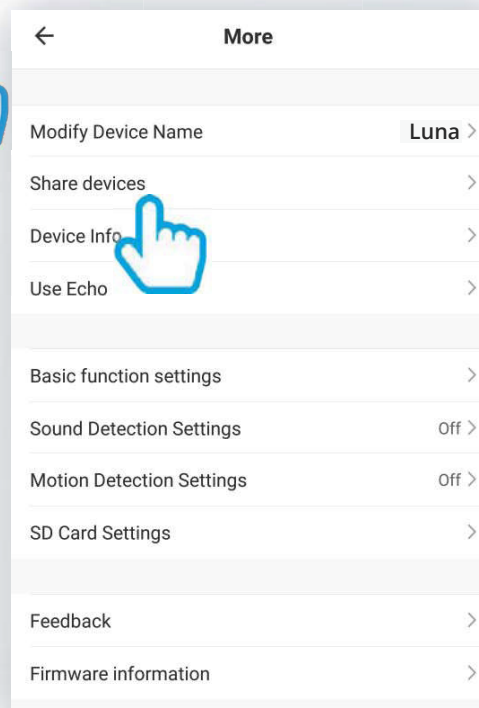

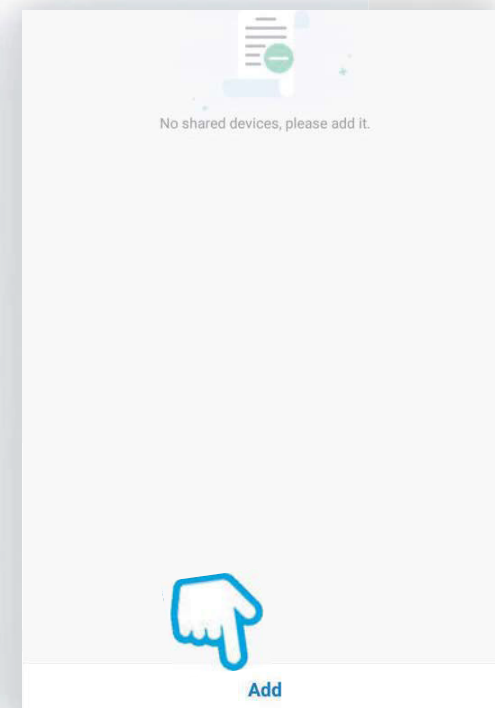

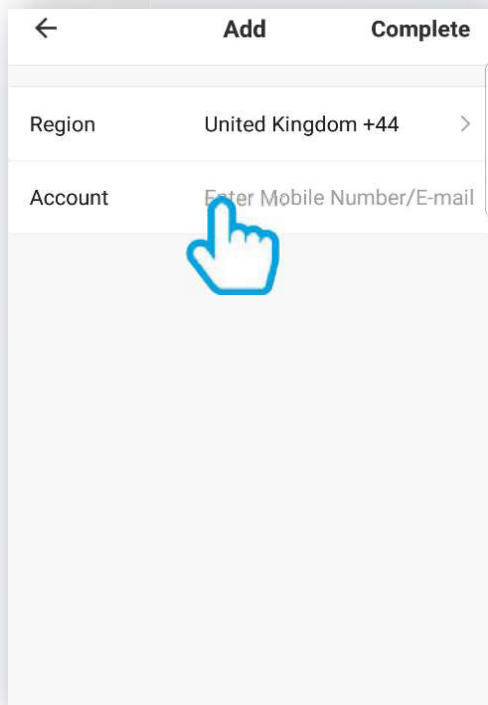

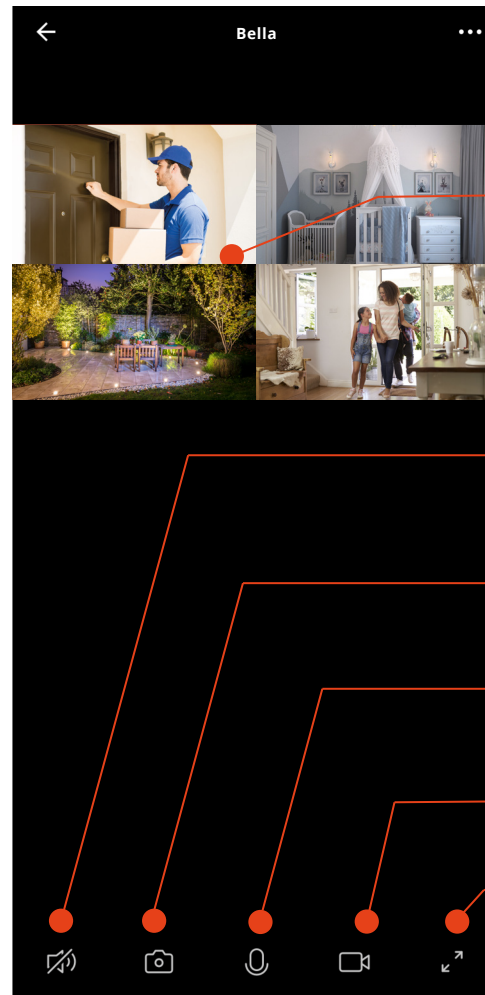
Multi Camera View

The multi-view feature allows you to view up to four Clan cameras at the same time.



Step 1

Click on the camera in the top right hand corner.



Click on a screen to be able to control it

Hear what's happening around your camera.

Save a screenshot on your smartphone memory.

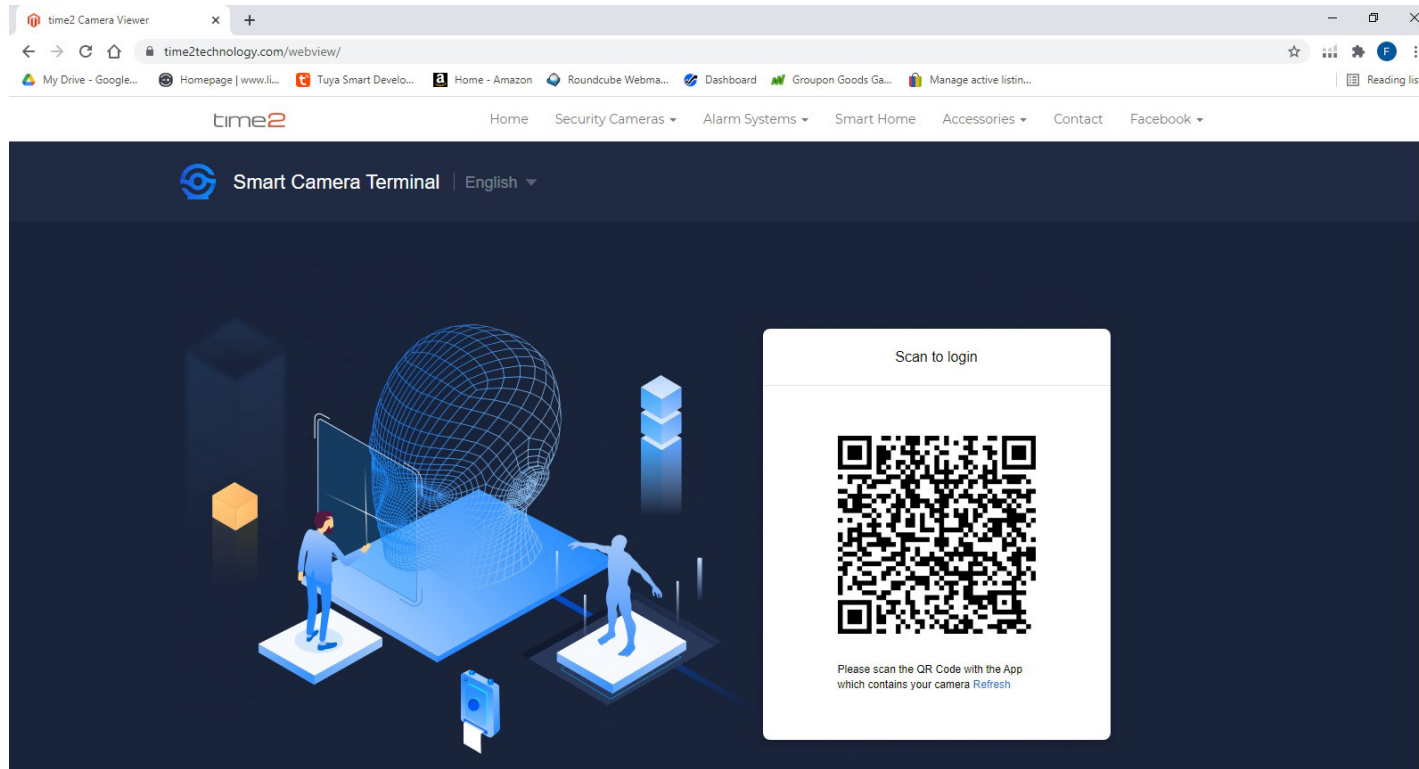
Select to speak into your camera.

Once Luna is set up, you are able to view it on your PC or laptop.

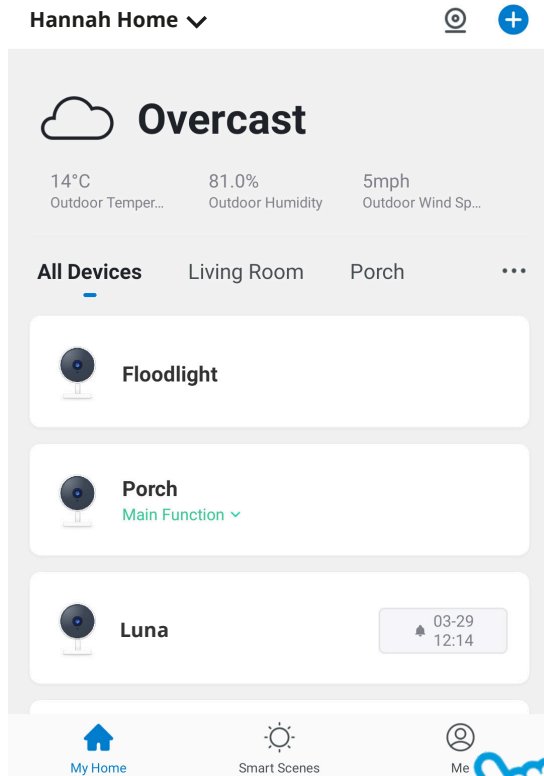

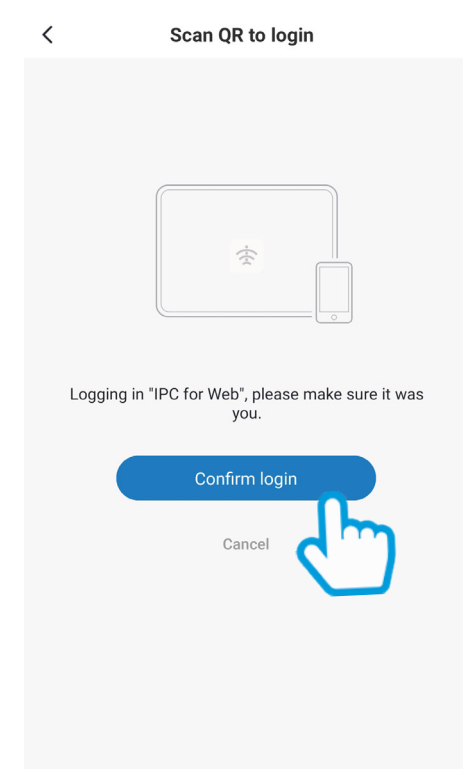

Safety Information

These instructions are intended to ensure that user can use the camera correctly to avoid danger or property loss.

Only use the original power adapter and accessories from the manufacturer.

Do not connect several cameras to one power source as adapter overload may cause over-heat or fire hazard.

Do not place the camera in extremely hot, cold, dusty or damp locations (the operating temperature should be -20°C ~ +55°C)

Do not drop the camera or subject it to physical shock. If you notice any smoke, odours or unusual noise coming from the camera, immediately unplug from power, and then contact Time2 customer services.

It is not permitted to open the camera yourself or to have it opened, neither is it permitted to repair the camera yourself or to have it repaired. This will void the warranty.

Disconnect the camera from all power sources before cleaning it. Use a clean, dry cloth to clean the product.

Do not use any abrasive agents, corrosive cleaning products or any substances that contain bleach or solvents to clean the camera.
